If so, leave them in the past, press forward with HIM, and begin a *new* lifestyle that honors HIM and leads you to that place of high calling (great accomplishment) in Christ! It’s time to focus on the *new*!

In the year ahead try this: Delete something from your life that you know you should not be doing and add something that you know you should be doing. Then, you will see the new creation growing within you! Have a Happy, prosperous, and God-centered *new* year!



Church Library


The church library is located in room 105 and is open during church office hours and when the church is open on Sundays and Wednesdays.
